nbn adds 21,000 premises to Victorian plan

Construction gathers momentum with multi-technology mix

21,000 additional Victorian homes and businesses are included in the **nbn**™ national construction plan update released today.

New areas that have been added to the rollout include, Berwick, Churchill, Sorrento, Port Fairy and Kinglake.

These latest additions mean there are now 430,000 homes and businesses across Victoria in areas where build will commence before December 2016.

The expansion of the fast broadband rollout program reflects **nbn's** new and flexible multi-technology mix (MTM) approach and is an important step toward reaching the company's goal of connecting eight million premises to the **nbn**^m network by 2020.

nbn™ spokesperson Michael Moore said:

"The addition of 21,000 Victorian homes and businesses to the **nbn** construction plan is good news for this state.

"It demonstrates that the rollout is gathering momentum, with the multi-technology mix set to ensure we get fast broadband to Australian homes and businesses in the most efficient, cost-effective manner."

nbn is planning to release three-year rollout plan in the near future, where more communities will be added to the roll out plan, including those in HFC areas.

- **nbn**'s strategic goals include connecting eight million premises to fast broadband and achieving annual revenue of \$4 billion by 2020.
- **nbn**'s current rollout schedule includes all technology in the Multi-Technology-Mix with the exception of HFC and the Long Term Satellite Service. These technologies will be added in a future forecast.
